


# START-UP: IN TOULOUSE (FRANCE), 10 REASONS TO BE PART OF THE ETHICS BIOTOPE IN 2018

## in digital healthcare:

• **DIGIKARE** is specialised in the digital support of patients before and after their orthopaedic operations. The start-up was launched in 2017 and has just launched a new product, «Orthense», structured around B2B2C, and which innovatively enables the digital follow-up of individualised care. The social security and healthcare authorities support the initiative as an innovative transformation project which also brings together the best practices of healthcare whilst also communicating key healthcare messages in an effective way.

The objective of DIGIKARE is to enable all patients to have a successful operating programme, adapted to their specific needs, and also guarantee the successful completion of their program of rehabilitation.



## in geo-spatial data management:

• GISAÏA, a start-up specialised in the field of Geo-BigData, creates new uses and new value via the exploitation of large volumes of spatial data, integration into visual displays following appropriate treatment. Their geographical explorer ARLAS enables the consultation and the statistical analysis of very large collections of spatial data with a remarkable fluidity and an improved user experience. This generic solution will be made available via Open source from February 2018.

## 5. GROW AND BLOSSOM IN A SPACE OF 1000 M<sup>2</sup>

Within the ETHICS biotope, the Biotopers benefit from two working spaces of 350 m2 divisible into between 4 and 6 private zones and from an open plan area of 350 m2, two shared meeting rooms and a relaxation area with terrace. They also have access to a reception, co-working areas, a design-thinking room, conference room (with live streaming), without forgetting the cafeteria.

Within these working areas, that are fully equipped with a fibre network and digital tools, the Biotopers can develop their projects comfortably with preferential accommodation conditions from 6 months to 3 years.

The ETHICS biotope can cater for up to 15 companies and their high value-added projects.

### 6. TAKE ADVANTAGE OF A STRATEGIC LOCATION

Served by the tram and with its own private car park, the ETHICS biotope is situated just a 5-minute walk from Toulouse-Blagnac Airport (ATB), the third regional airport in France with over 9,2 million passengers in 2017 and an annual growth of 14,6 %.

The ETHICS biotope also offers privileged access to the new Toulouse Exhibition and Convention Center which is currently under construction. This headline project will highlight the brilliance of the Toulouse metropolitan area, with an investment of over 400 million Euros, and will confirm the north-west corner of the city as the principal economic centre of the Toulouse metropolis. When it is inaugurated in 2020, the new exhibition centre will be the third largest in France, and is designed to welcome fairs, lounges, conventions, large congresses (from 3 000 to 12 000 people) and also important cultural and sporting events.

# 7. TAKE ADVANTAGE OF A METROPOLITAN DYNAMIC WHICH IS AT THE HEART OF CURRENT EVENTS

The Toulouse metropolis, the aeronautics and space capital of Europe, represents a region that is extraordinarily favourable for the emergence of a culture that is both economic and intellectual, scientific and technological, artistic and creative.

In 2018, Toulouse takes over from Manchester as the European City of Science. It will welcome the 8th edition of the ESOF (Euro Science Open Forum) for the first time in France. Around 5 000 researchers and economic players from around the world are expected for this event which is scheduled to take place between the 9th and 14th July. Toulouse will also be the host city for the 6th edition of the Toulouse Space Show, the 14th international conference of FabLabs bringing together more than 1 000 FabLabs from around the planet and also the 25th conference of the International Planetarium Society (IPS)

# 8. INSTALL YOURSELF IN A HIGH GROWTH AREA WHERE IT'S GOOD TO LIVE AND WORK

By installing yourself at the Ethics Biotope you are installing yourself at the heart of an area with some of the highest economic and demographic growth rates in France.

Credited with more than 150,000 additional inhabitants in the last 10 years for a total population estimated



at 1.3 million inhabitants, the Toulouse metropolitan area continues to record a real demographic boom of the order of 15,000 additional inhabitants a year.

Identified as the leading French metropolitan area, outside of the Ile-de-France, for the evolution of its population, it also leads the hexagon with regards to the growth of the number of jobs (more than 70,000 additional employees in 10 years, giving a total of over 500,000 jobs) and for the growth of its GDP (Gross Domestic Product): +2,93 % in 10 years. This same dynamic can also be found in the number of students: 115,000. The metropolitan area is regularly classified at the top of the rankings of French cities where people like to study or work.

### 9. DEVELOP YOURSELF IN THE GEO-STRATEGIC REGION OF OCCITANIA

The critical size of the new Occitania region being around 72,724 km², it is larger than 13 countries within the European Union, and with an accumulated GDP (Gross Domestic Product) in excess of 150 Billion Euros. In 2017, the region passed the barrier of 1,2 million jobs, with a growth rate of 2% compared to 1.6% in the rest of France. New business start-ups jumped by 4.1% (8.8% if you take into account the entrepreneurs).

Besides its aeronautical and spatial activity which gives rise to its global industrial reputation, Occitania is also one of the cradles of French Tech which is specialised in the Internet of Things, embarked systems, multimedia and video games.

Occitania attracts more than 30 million tourists every year with a revenue of around 13 Billion Euros. The new region includes more than 5,000 historic monuments (the third largest region in France) and groups 17% of the properties registered on the list of the UNESCO for France...
